Example1

問題4の解答欄

Example1

Considering that many university students today are concerned about their employment prospects, it is not surprising that social science majors are much more in number than those studying humanities, not directly related to a career. Speaking of career paths, I expect that the fields of engineering and health, accounting for 14.6% and 12.9% respectively, will gain more popularity in the near future. The reason is that information technology is the most promising industry, whereas Japan is a super-aging society with growing medical needs among its elderly population. (87words)

Example2

There are a few new trends, which all have something to do with practical value. One trend is that more students are interested in Engineering than Humanities. This could be because, as students witness more technology applied to their daily life, they are more conscious of how to 'use' their knowledge and skills on the job. Another trend is that the percentage of students majoring in Health is almost as large as that of Humanities. This also indicates they want to study something directly related to their future job. (88words)

Example3

The pie chart shows almost half of the university students study in social science and humanities (so-called bunkei majors). Students majoring in engineering, natural science, and agriculture (so-called rikei majors) account for about 20%, which seems surprisingly small for the future of Japan. The rate of the bunkei-majoring students, especially of social science students, should be limited to 15% and more students should major in rikei majors. Other majors like arts, humanities, and health are too important to spare in our lifestyles. (82words)
